Health and Dental Insurance Assistance from CHCFC



Open Enrollment for the Health Connector has ended BUT you can still apply for health and dental insurance coverage

if you are eligible. You are eligible if you qualify for MassHealth (this is based on income). You may also be eligible if you have a life qualifying event such as: losing employer's insurance, change in income, change in family size (this could be due to marriage, birth, adoption, death), or if you are new to the area.

The Community Health Center of Franklin County (CHCFC) has a Health Connector Navigator that can help you! Wendy Gaida is available to answer questions and assist you with the application process. Call her at 413-325-8500, extension 146.

CHCFC has medical, dental, and behavioral health offices at 119 New Athol Road in Orange and 102 Main Street in Greenfield. They are accepting new patients and accept most insurances.
